The following acts committed by the defendant constitute all of the necessary elements of the crime of Perjury in the first degree in violation of section 14-70.1 of the Cherokee Code: The defendant, in an official proceeding made a false statement under oath or equivalent affirmation.

Per DV24-1025, Amanda Woodall made multiple false statements included within.

On page four, Woodall marked the box on number one stating she (Plaintiff) currently lives within the territory of the Eastern Band of Cherokee Indians. Woodall does not reside within EBCI territory, as noted on page ten.

On page four, number three- Woodall marked that there was not another court proceeding or existing court order between her and the defendant. Woodall and the defendant (Jonah Carey) have an ongoing custody order (CV15-532) that has had multiple modifications/contempt motions.

On page four, number four and five- Woodall states, "the defendant has been accused of sexually abusing the minor child." This accusation was brought forth in August of 2018, and an investigation was done. With no evidence to pursue charges, the case was closed, and Woodall was made aware of the findings.

On page seven, number one- Woodall again checks the box stating that she currently lives within the territory of the EBCI. As stated above, per page ten, she has not lived on the boundary since 2022, and per Woodalls' personal handwritten statement she advised, "We even moved out of state to feel safe."

On page seven, number three- Woodall checks the box regarding offenses and the sex offense box. As stated above, the accusation from August of 2018 was unfounded and she was made aware of the findings. Carey has not seen the minor child since December of 2018. (Note: the accusation and child safety investigation from December 2018 was substantiated.)

On page ten, Woodall states that she moved from Cherokee in November of 2022 to Tennessee of the same month. Woodall did not add the Georgia address, where she admits to living at in Order (Custody) filling from February of 2024 (CV15-532). The admittance is on page three, under "Findings in Fact," number twelve and thirteen.

On page ten, Woodall does not check a box that is stated, "I have participated in litigation concerning the custody of the above named child." Woodall does not check a box that is stated, "I have information of a custody proceeding concerning the above named child pending in a court in this or another." Woodall has been a part of multiple court sessions regarding CV15-532, which is a child custody order.

On the "Client Statement Justification for Service" paper, Woodall made a handwritten statement. She stated, "The sexual abuse was not talked about in our custody trial." That is a false statement- there are multiple pieces of evidence that was admitted into CV15-532 speaking of the sexual assault allegations. The allegations of sexual assault was discussed on: 12/19/2018 where there is doctors notes regarding the sexual assault, and there was 47 "CAC Intake Progress Notes" from Therapist Amanda Hatfield introduced into evidence in December of 2023.

Woodall decided to get a Domestic Violence Protection Order while she was in Cherokee for the minor child's court ordered therapy session, to further diminish the possibility of visitations for Carey. The DVPO was completed with falsified statements and information provided by Woodall to Magistrate Crowe.
